Read all directions carefully before installing your Cobra freeway bar

- 1. Remove the (3) 6mm radiator bolts (1 upper and 2 lower) and set aside. (Do not remove radiator hose).
- 2. Take the upper black powder coated mounting bracket making sure the outside bent mounting tabs are facing backwards, then slide between the frame and radiator from the **left side** of the bike by pulling the radiator forward with one hand and sliding the bracket through with the other, **be extremely careful not to damage the radiator!**
- 3. Install the 5/16 x 5/8 Flanged bolts provided through the backside of the frame cross member into the threaded inserts of the mounting bracket (See figure 1). **Do not tighten bolts at this time.**
- 4. Remove left front floorboard to frame 10mm mounting bolt and set aside.
- 5. Remove right front floorboard to frame 10mm mounting bolt & nut and set aside.
- 6. Slide Cobra freeway bar in from the left side making sure the lower mounting brackets of bar are facing backwards, be careful not to damage radiator or the front fender.
- 7. Lift freeway bar up into place with mounting tabs on the outside of floor board mounts and start left & right mounting bolts set aside from steps 4 & 5. **Do not tighten at this time.**
- 8. Rotate freeway bar into place with bar mounting tabs outside the upper mounting bracket installed in step 2. Start 3/8 x 7/8 button head allen bolts (2) provided through outside of freeway bar and mounting bracket, place 10mm flat washer and 3/8 Nylock nuts provided onto bolts.
- 9. Tighten the (2) 5/16 mounting bolts from step 3. then tighten the (2) 10mm right & left freeway bar to floor board bolts from step 4 & 5, and finally the (2) 3/8 bolts with nuts from step 8. Torque all hardware to factory torque specifications.
- 10. Re-install (3) 6mm bolts through radiator, into frame from step 1.
- 11. Check to make sure all hardware is tight and everything is in good working order before riding.


