Read your installation instructions completely before beginning. This tachometer can be installed using common tools. It is recommended however, that a qualified mechanic or technician install this product.		
 Your tachometer comes with everything you need to mount and wire it to your motorcycle. Remove the two mounting screws and screw caps from the left side of the handlebar clamp. Insert the long spacer into the front hole and the short spacer into the rear hole. (refer to fig 1) Align the two holes in the tachometer mount with the two holes in the handlebar clamp, insert and tighten the provided screws to factory specifications. (refer to fig 1) Remove the 3 screws that attach the headlight bezel to the headlight housing. Remove the headlight bezel leaving the housing attached to the motorcycle frame. Route the tachometer wires next to the speedometer wire and into the back of the headlight. Inside the headlight housing attach the blue and red tachometer wires to the black w/brown stripe wire that comes from the speedometer using the supplied quick slide connector. Attach the black tachometer wire to the green motorcycle turnsignal ground wire with the supplied quick slide connector. Connect the green tachometer wire to the yellow coil wire in the headlight. (Refer to schematic) Zip tie the tachometer wires to the speedometer wire near the base of the speedometer. Reattach the headlight bezel with the 3 screws removed in step 4.
