- 1. Remove the stock front M8 screws retaining the chrome fender rail / fender on each side of the rear fender. Replace these screws with the bungee knobs and supplied M8 x 65 mm buttonhead screws. Do not tighten the screws completely at this time. The stock screws will not be reused.
- 2. Remove the stock rear M8 screws retaining the chrome fender rail / fender on each side of the rear fender. Replace these screws with the bungee knobs and supplied M8 x 60 mm buttonhead screws. Do not tighten the screws completely at this time. The stock screws will not be reused.
- 3. With all components aligned and installed tighten the buttonhead screws to factory specifications.

- 2. Remove the stock rear M8 screws retaining the chrome fender rail / fender on each side of the rear fender. Replace these screws with the bungee knobs and supplied M8 x 60 mm buttonhead screws. Do not tighten the screws completely at this time. The stock screws will not be reused.
- 3. With all components aligned and installed tighten the buttonhead screws to factory specifications.
