- 1. Remove the two (2) rear bolts on each fender rail, first on the right side.
- 2. Install the brackets with the bent portion (part number) toward the inside using the stock bolts and tighten. Brackets will mount on the outside of fender rail. Repeat on left side.
- 3. Install the sissy bar to the brackets using the supplied 8mm x 20mm bolts and tighten. Tighten all hardware, torque the bolts installed in the fender rail to factory specifications.
