

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- 7. The mounting plate assembly is ready to be attached to the motorcycle. Attach the hoses and hose clamps that were disconnected in Step 2, to the inlet tubes on the mounting plate. Install the rubber boot onto the throttle body but leave the clamp loose for now.
- Align the holes in the support bracket with threaded holes in the cylinder heads, then insert the (2) supplied M6 x 20mm buttonhead bolts through the support bracket, supplied spacers and into the cylinder heads. See Figure 2.
- 9. Align and level the mounting plate assembly so the air cleaner will sit straight, then fully tighten the clamp over the throttle body, then the bolt that secures the support bracket to the mounting plate, followed by the M6 bolts in the cylinders.
- 10. Place the supplied K&N® filter onto the velocity stack.

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- 11. Remove the intake cover from the box and insert the intake screen into place so the holes in the bent tabs align with the threaded bosses in the intake cover.
- Place intake cover over the mounting plate assembly and align the mounting holes to the threaded bosses. Insert the (3) supplied ¼"-20 x 5/8" flange bolts and tighten the mounting plate to the intake cover. See Figure 3.
